

## COSGAYA – PEMBES FACTSHEET

Distance: 4 k

Time: 1 hour

Difficulty: Low

Area: Picos de Europa – Cantabria

### Walk 3 : Cosgaya – Pemes

From the hotel we take a path that starts beside the swimming pool and gradually gains height until, at a sharp left bend, we leave the main track and go through a small gate, carrying straight on along a narrower track. While this heads towards a small plantation of pines, we take a path from which we can see Llaves church in the distance.

The path goes through an oak wood covering the foothills of Sierra Vileña. We reach a small meadow called Campo la Santa. The summit we see to the right, above Treviño (part of Cosgaya), is Pico Jano. Before us to the left is Sierra Carielda, ahead in the distance the Macizo Oriental, and to the right Peña Oviedo. We can also see the villages of Llaves and Pemes.

We do a 180 degrees turn and carry on through open woodland with the village of Pemes never out of sight.
